

**The TQC Foundation Offers at Minimum 16 College and Vocational Scholarships to High School Seniors Graduating in 2022**

**The Tallahassee Quarterback Club Foundation, a 401(c)(3) charitable organization, provides merit scholarships to attend college and vocational schools. The TQC Foundation provides scholarships to seniors attending school in one of 11 North Florida counties (Leon, Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Jackson, Jefferson, Liberty, Madison, Suwannee, and Wakulla). Applicants must have a 3.0 unweighted or 3.25 weighted cumulative GPA. In addition, the applicant must be an active participant in school or community. The applicant does not need to participate in athletics to be considered. Finally, the applicant must have overcome a significant mental, physical, emotional, or environmental challenge to be considered for this scholarship.**

**To date, over 300 scholarships have been awarded to students with benefits exceeding four million dollars. The Foundation will evaluate each application, including academic achievements, character, school and community involvement, and the nature of the challenge the applicant has overcome. Scholarship applications must be submitted by mail starting November 22, 2021, through February 16, 2022.**

**The Foundation scholarship winners will attend the annual Biletnikoff Award Banquet, recognized as the outstanding college football banquet in**

America, on Saturday, March 5th, 2022, at Tallahassee's University Center Club. The banquet is hosted by the TQC Foundation, which created and sponsored the Biletnikoff Award in 1994. The Biletnikoff Award recognizes the college football season's outstanding receiver, regardless of position. The award is considered one of the most prestigious in college football.

**TO BE ELIGIBLE**, the applicant must have compiled either an overall unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or an overall weighted high school GPA of 3.25 and attend a public, private, charter, or virtual high school in Calhoun, Franklin, Gadsden, Gulf, Jackson, Jefferson, Leon, Liberty, Madison, Suwannee, or Wakulla county. The applicant does NOT have to play a high school sport to qualify.

Please mail a high-quality headshot photo and, if you wish, up to 4 photos with captions explaining the specific activity (school, organization, sports, religious, or community activity) in which you are engaging during the time the photo is taken. Include your name and school on the photo. The headshot photo is used for projecting your image on the video screen for banquet patrons to view.
